Construction:

This Seamaster 30 was designed by John Welch and built by Seamaster Ltd in Dunmow Eassex in 1980, commissioned 1981.

Centre cockpit design with hull, decks and coach roof constructed in GRP.

The interior is fitted out in mahogany and carpeted in blue in the wheelhouse with biege in the saloon, stern cabin and forward cabin.

12V battery pack with 2 domestic and 2 engine batteries.

240V shorepower and cable.

Wheelhouse:

Single pilot and navigator seats covered in tan leatherette type material.

Additional bench seating behind the navigator's position

Wheelhouse area is fully enclosed with a combination of wheelhouse roof and awning in blue waterproof fabric.

Saloon:

Biege carpeted saloon area with D-shaped soft biege fabric covered cushioned seating area. The seating area is convertible to a double berth.

Folding formica finished dining table.

Storage cupboards and drawers in the saloon and galley area giving generous capacity.

Eberspacher hot-air heating diesel-fired unit supplying heat to all cabins.

Adjacent to the saloon on the starboard side is a sea toilet compartment with wash hand basin and shower.

Stern Cabin

2 large single beds.

Forward Cabin

Cabin has a V-berth fitted with infill capability.

Galley:

A well equipped galley with good storage capacity is located on the starboard side of the saloon.

Counter tops are finished in formica.

Stainless steel sink, supplied with pressurised hot and cold water.

2-burner gas oven and grill.

Front-loaded refrigerator.
