All her deck gear is new from Harken and Spinlock. She had new running rigging in 2015 and most of her standing stainless steel rigging has been replaced. Her main and genoa are all in very good condition having been very lightly used.

The Javelin 30 represents the very best in design from this era of IOR half tonners. She qualifies for the production division of the half tonne cup and the classic circuit. She is an economical and enjoyable way of getting involved with ocean racing either offshore or around the cans on a Thursday night. With her almost new sails and great IRC rating, 'Salamis' is a definite winner.
