Designed and built in 1987 by Aquastar St Peter Port, Guernsey, Channel Islands
GRP hull deck & superstructure
Hard chine below the waterline designed for stability & rigidity
Toughened glass panoramic windows
Semi-displacement underwater profile

Twin bronze spade hung rudders
