Mechanical and Rigging

Construction:

GRP constructed yacht with 1.6M cast iron keel and transom hung rudder and tiller steering. White topsides with smart blue and silver hull decals. Aluminium toerail. Underwater areas antifouled, anodes changed, and hull topsides polished in April 2019. Self bailing cockpit with sail locker to port. Cockpit mouldings curved for comfort. Stainless steel bow and stern rails connected by stanchions and guard wire. Self bailing anchor locker with lid. Stainless steel stem head fitting with bow roller. Foredeck hatch fitted with solar powered vent.

Engine & Electrics:

Vessel powered by a reliable and economical inboard Yanmar 1GM10 diesel. Engine serviced in early May 2019. This single cylinder, 9hp unit is located beneath the companionway steps. Engine start panel with visual/audible alarm for oil pressure water temperature and charging. Reduction gearbox driving stainless steel shaft and 2-bladed bronze propeller. 2X12V batteries fitted with isolators. The batteries are charged via the engine alternator or the onboard battery charger. Shore power with cable.

Sails & Rigging:

Bermudan masthead sloop rig with deck stepped aluminium spars. Stainless steel standing rigging with new forestay and Furllex roller furling system 2017. Terylene running rigging in excellent condition. Majority of which led aft. Slab reefing main mounted in lazybag on the boom. Roller furling genoa. Spinnaker with pole and associated rigging. Harken self tailing halyard and sheet winches. Mainsheet track in the cockpit.

Accommodation

Below decks is bright and comfortable. Although the headroom isn't 6-foot plus, there are enough decent features to make up for it. The level of accommodation is more in keeping with a larger boat and offers a decent aft cabin, well equipped galley and a good sized heads compartment.

The saloon is entered via the companionway with large sliding hatch and perspex wash boards. Immediately to starboard is the galley area featuring a stainless steel sink with pumped fresh cold water. There is a Plastimo gas fueled oven with 2-burner hob and grill. Top loading icebox for perishables and cubby storage to rear.

Aft of the galley is the aft cabin with a double berth and hanging space. The cabin has fixed ports to coachroof and cockpit for natural light.

Opposite galley is a shelved storage unit. Immediately aft is the heads compartment with sea toilet and sink unit. There is a chart table with switch panel and navigation instruments at the rear end of the port settee.

Central saloon table with drop leaves. Settees/berths port and starboard with stowage below. In the forepeak, there is a double berth. This is utilised by lowering the saloon seating backrest.

Remarks :

The Jouet 760 is a super little craft ideal as a first time boat or for those looking to downsize. The design by Philippe Briand is amazing with every spare inch used to the max. There are some 30 footers which don't offer the same level of accommodation, and she sails well too.

This yacht has been lovingly maintained and is in a sail away condition. Hull has been antifouled, topsides polished, engine serviced and all sparkly down below.

She has a proper aft cabin, spacious heads, galley with full oven, chart table, comfy saloon and a massive cockpit. Deck stepped spars with lines led aft she is ideal for short-handed sailing. Decent navigation aids including chart plotter, auto pilot, GPS, DSC VHF and depth sounder.
