All decks were re-laid with Flexiteak in 2015. Powered by twin Yanmar 260hp diesel engines. PIROGUE offers a double aft, en suite owners cabin and a twin forward cabin with a huge amount of stowage in both. Spacious and comfortable deck saloon/ wheelhouse with linear galley and dining table opposite with excellent all round visibility. Large guarter deck for socialising or sunbathing as well as a flybridge. Her decks are wide and safe with the protection of guardrails and plenty of grab handles. Prestigious marina berth available by negotiation. Currently afloat on the River Dart in Dartmouth.

CONSTRUCTION AND MECHANICAL

Built in 2003 Built by Corvette Marine Ltd in Reedham, Norwich.

- Flexiteak laid wide side decks, fore deck, aft deck and flybridge (2015)
- Teak capping rail
- Interior and flybridge helms
- Stainless steel folding radar arch (Air Draft, 3.25 metres)

Flybridge:

- Excellent all round visibility
- Seating up to 7
- White leather upholstery with blue piping
- 3 swivel seats with covers at helm, which reverse to face aft
- Further seating aft with storage under
- Grabrails all round
- Dodgers for wind protection/ privacy
- Fold down radar arch

Wide steps down to:

Quarterdeck:

- Outdoor entertaining / sunbathing area
- Dodgers all round for wind protection and privacy



- Fold down ladder
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Engines:

- Twin Yanmar 6LP-DTP 260hp diesel engines
- · Accessed via wheelhouse floor
- Approximately 245 hours running
- Shaft drive to fixed propellers
- Ultraflex morse lever controls (dual station)
- Cruising speed approximately 15 knots
- Maximum speed approximately 20 knots
- Trim Tabs (dual station controls)

Electrics:

- 12v system
- 1 x engine and 1 x domestic battery (2016)
- Charged by engine alternator and 240v battery charger
- Shore power
- Shore power cable
- 240v ring main with sockets in all cabins
