CONSTRUCTION, MECHANICAL AND RIGGING

Built by Hanse Yachts AG, Germany to a design by Jodel and Vrolijk

- White GRP hull, deck and superstructure
- Coppercoated epoxy resin based antifouling
- Grey stripe and two grey bootlines around topside
- Teak laid slats to cockpit seats and cockpit sole
- Iron fin keel with ballast bulb
- Semi- balanced, profiled rudder with alloy shaft and slf aligning needle bearings
- Self draining cockpit to seat 6
- 'A' category Ocean
- Steering wheel with leather cover
- Bow thruster operated by cockpit control or remote

Engine:

- Volvo Penta D1-20 18hp triple cylinder diesel engine (No: 51023650290)
- Approximately 46 hours running
- 2-bladed aluminium propeller
- Volvo Penta Saildrive
- Balanced GRP rudder
- Rod link steering system

- 1 x engine battery (in locker under companionway steps)

Rigging:

- Fractional rigged sloop
- Self tacking foresail
- Selden silver anodised aluminium mast and boom
- Mast stepped by cast aluminium deck post supported by internal metal kingpost that runs down to keel
- 2 sets of mast spreaders
- Cam cleats for halyards (on coachroof)
- Self tacking jib track
- Running rigging (jib sheet, jib furling control rope, topping lift, mainsheet, kicking strap, 2 x halyards)
- Forestay
- Split backstay
- 5mm and 600 1 x 19 stainless steel standing rigging
- Main sheet well forward from cockpit
- Halyards all lead aft to cockpit

- Fully battened main with slab reefing
- Self tacking roller furling jib with UV sacrificial strip

Winches:

- 2 x Lewmar 40 AST combined self tailing winches for halyard and jib sheet
- 2 x Lewmar self tacking halyard winches (on coachroof)

The Hanse 355 has a low, sleek cabintop, long waterline and a generous beam which make her both look and feel thoroughly modern. She is a quick boat designed to be easily handled by a small crew. She has a single wheel and a more enclosed cockpit. STAR IN THE WIND has a full cockpit canopy which adds usuable space when on a mooring.
