

Bavaria 39 Cruiser, built by Bavaria Yachts, Germany in 2006 to a design by J and J Design.

- White GRP hull, deck and superstructure
- Teak decks

- Fin with bulb keel
- Last antifouled January 2017, re-launched May 2017
- Saildrive anode replaced January 2017

- Volvo D2-40 40 hp 4 cylinder diesel engine
