

## Remarks:

St. Francis Marine has been building luxury ocean cruising catamarans since 1989. The standard design incorporates four double berth en suite cabins with heads, basins, bathtubs, and showers with white beech wood throughout. The galley is a cook's delight, with stove, microwave, fridge, freezer, and double-bowl sink. The open-plan saloon has 360-degree visibility and can comfortably seat eight. The large navigation station can be seen clearly from the helm or while seated at the cockpit table. A husband-and-wife team can easily manage the boat during 200-mile-or-more days under sail, and can motor at 10 knots.
