Hull & Decks

GPR laid up in polyester resin with gelcoat finish Iroko keel plank and protective stemband Twin galvanised steel drop keels. Lifted and lowered by winches Transom hung rudder with controllable drop plate All the hull fitted joinery is in Iroko, and finished with Burgess Hydro Seal resin Rudder is hardwood and marine ply with galvanised mild steel controllable drop plate GPR Decks
Wooden gunnels and deck joinery is in Iroko, and finished with Burgess Hydro Seal resin
