Designed by Henningsen and Steckmest she was commissioned by her previous owner, who developed hydraulics machinery for agriculture and ships. Her Hull is double-planked mahogany with decks in Teak. Noringa was fitted out in 1967 by Abeking and Rasmussen in Germany and again in 1979 for sailing 2nd category under French flag in Cannes La Bocca.
