Broker Remarks

'Luxury' is the word that sums up these South African built Knysna catamarans. For anyone looking at Lagoons and other cats in this price range, this Knysna 500 SE (Special Edition) is well worth looking at. It will be clear from even the smallest amount of research into the Knysna company that these yachts are a level above the usual.

With an impressive owners suite, taking up the entirety of one of the hulls, this catamaran would make a very stylish live aboard, or an idyllic escape for the summer months.

A rare opportunity to acquire a highly equipped 2019 Knysna 500 SE, commissioned in the summer of that year and maintained exclusively as a private cruising yacht.

Designed for comfortable, fast and self-sufficient bluewater cruising, this three-cabin Owner's Version combines the well-regarded Knysna 500 SE platform with a comprehensive cruising specification, including lithium energy storage, extensive solar capacity, a watermaker, air conditioning, a generator and an excellent sail inventory.

The yacht has been privately owned from new and has never been



chartered, with the owner personally aboard whenever she has moved — a distinctive ownership history compared with many charter-oriented catamarans currently on the market. She is currently based in Motril, southern Spain, and is presented in very good to excellent condition, with a small number of cosmetic and maintenance items in hand ahead of completion.

Broker's Remarks

This Knysna 500 SE stands out for her ownership history: a single private owner since new, no charter use, and an owner who has been aboard for every passage. That combination is unusual in today's catamaran market and gives real confidence to a buyer looking for a genuinely private cruising yacht rather than a former charter boat.

The three-cabin Owner's Version layout is well suited to a couple or small family taking on extended cruising, and the bespoke interior redesign gives the accommodation a contemporary, sophisticated feel beyond the standard specification. Below decks, the substantial lithium and solar installation, generator, watermaker and air conditioning give her genuine self-sufficiency for Mediterranean cruising and further afield, while the low generator and watermaker hours reflect an owner who has looked after his equipment.

A small number of cosmetic and maintenance items are currently in

hand at a planned haul-out in Motril,
giving the next owner the benefit of a
freshly attended-to yacht without
having to organise the work
themselves. Early inspection is
recommended.

The interior of this Knysna 500 SE has been individually redesigned by the owner to create a contemporary and sophisticated living environment, combining the generous volume and sleek lines of the 500 SE with a modern aesthetic.

The Owner's Version provides three cabins and generous private accommodation, well suited to an owner couple or family undertaking extended cruising.

Domestic

The galley is equipped with a Smeg 2-plate induction hob, a Smeg 2-plate gas hob, a Bosch combination oven and microwave, an Isotherm combi fridge unit, an Isotherm freezer, a Vitrifrigo ice box, a Midea dishwasher and a Weber barbecue. The yacht is fitted with air conditioning and three electric toilets.

Known Defects

A number of items are currently in hand ahead of completion of the sale, to be addressed at a planned haul-out in Motril:

- Cosmetic finishing items
- Canvas – repair/replacement in hand
- Coppercoat antifouling – condition check
- Propeller – folding blade mechanism reported by the owner, to be inspected and resolved

History

This Knysna 500 SE was commissioned in the summer of 2019 and has enjoyed a clear and attractive ownership history. She has been privately owned from new, never placed into charter service, and operated throughout as a personal cruising yacht,

with the owner personally aboard whenever the vessel has moved – a significant distinction for buyers seeking a genuinely private cruising catamaran rather than a former charter vessel.

The interior has been individually redesigned by the owner. The yacht has been hauled out every autumn and stored ashore for approximately seven months each winter, with the standing rigging inspected in 2022. She is now based in Motril, southern Spain, where a haul-out is planned to normal winter maintenance program.
