Powered by a **Volvo MD22 59hp diesel**, she offers comfortable accommodation for up to **seven in four cabins**, comprising two doubles and three singles, together with the considerable convenience of **two heads**.

The beautifully appointed interior features **solid teak and teak-veneered joinery**, approximately **1.98m (6'6") headroom**, attractive red upholstery and a **Refleks diesel heater**, creating a warm and welcoming environment ideally suited to extended cruising.

The well-equipped galley includes a stainless-steel two-burner cooker with oven and grill, double stainless-steel sink, 12V refrigerator with keel cooler and microwave oven. A comprehensive **suite of navigation equipment**, together with the large cockpit and excellent storage, further enhances her cruising credentials.

Accommodation

The Trident Warrior 40 offers exceptionally comfortable and characterful accommodation, combining traditional craftsmanship with the practicality required for extended cruising. The interior features beautifully finished **solid teak and teak-veneered joinery**, creating a warm, elegant and timeless ambience, complemented by attractive **red upholstery** throughout.

With approximately **1.98m (6'6") headroom**, the accommodation is remarkably spacious for a vessel of this type and provides **two double berths and three single berths**, making her an excellent proposition for family cruising or extended stays aboard. A **Refleks diesel heater** provides efficient heating and adds considerably to onboard comfort during colder periods.

The well-appointed galley is equipped for serious cruising, featuring a **stainless-steel two-burner gas cooker with oven and grill**, double stainless-steel sink, **12V refrigerator with keel cooler**, microwave oven, gas alarm and a comprehensive range of crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils.

Two separate heads compartments provide excellent convenience, each fitted with a **Lavac marine manual toilet, handbasin and shower**. Pressurised hot and cold water is supplied by both the engine and **240V immersion heater**.

The **large aft cockpit** is a particular feature, providing an excellent social and entertaining area with comfortable seating and generous storage lockers. Overall, the accommodation offers a highly practical yet traditional cruising environment, with quality joinery, excellent headroom and facilities ideally suited to comfortable extended cruising.

Mechanical and Rigging

Sails and Spars:

The Warrior 40 has a Cutter Bermudan Kemp deck-stepped mast and boom with a fractional rig. It has a slab reefing mainsail and furling headsail. It has an alloy spinnaker pole and manually adjustable backstay. The age of the stainless steel standing rigging is unknown. It has a Harken twin furling headsail system for both headsails. It has a jibe preventer and carbon fibre spinnaker pole fitted.

Mechanical:

This Warrior 40 has a Volvo MD22 4-cylinder 59HP diesel engine located under the aft cockpit sole. Freshwater-cooled via a heat exchanger. Shaft drive to a three-blade feathering Max-Prop. The fuel tank is stainless steel and holds approximately



190 Litres. This yacht will cruise at approximately 7 knots and has a maximum speed of approximately 8.5 knots. It has a Vetus 7.5 kW bow thruster.

Electrical Systems:

This vessel is equipped with 4 x 12V 130Ah batteries and 2 x 108AH (4 x domestic batteries, 1 x engine and 1 x bow thruster. These batteries are all charged by the engine alternator and via a 240V Victron amp battery charger. It has an ADVERC Battery management system and monitor fitted.

This yacht also benefits from 240-volt shore power, with outlets throughout the vessel, along with a 240-volt immersion heater.

History and Construction:

This Trident Warrior 40 was built in 19989 and commissioned in 1990 by Trident Marine to a **Bill Dixon** design. The boat has a white GRP hull with a white superstructure and decks with grey non-slip surfaces, with stainless steel stanchions, a stainless-steel pulpit, a fin keel with a skeg rudder and a self-draining cockpit. The current owner has passed away, and the yacht is being sold by his widow.

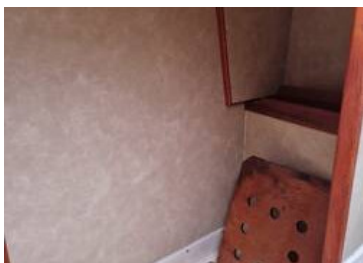
