Accommodation

On the exterior, the Dual Cockpit takes on new meaning. The twin helms are positioned forward, and even feature an exterior chart table with a GPS screen and autopilot controls, all sheltered by the hard top and the wide, wrap-a-round windscreen, offering remarkable visibility.
