With RINA C + HULL • MACH • Y classification, she offers strong build integrity and offshore capability. Accommodation is arranged for 8 guests in 4 cabins (2 double, 2 twin), providing spacious and well-proportioned interiors finished with high quality joinery.

Powered by twin 265 HP Volvo Penta engines and supported by twin 17.5 kW Kohler generators, she delivers reliable cruising performance. Her wide aft deck, traditional bangaça relaxation area and balanced sailing profile make her ideal for long Mediterranean voyages.

Accommodation

Accommodation is arranged for 8 guests in 4 cabins comprising 2 double cabins and 2 twin cabins. All cabins are finished in high quality varnished wood joinery consistent with traditional Bodrum craftsmanship. Each cabin benefits from en-suite facilities and air conditioning. Separate crew accommodation for 3. Spacious saloon area with interior helm station. Designed for comfortable long-term Mediterranean cruising.

Mechanical and Rigging

Powered by twin 265HP Volvo Penta diesel engines with TwinDisc V Drive (2.5:1 ratio) and shaft drive configuration. Fuel capacity 3,500 litres stainless steel tank. Twin 17.5kW Kohler generators provide reliable onboard power. Hull speed approximately 10 knots. Traditional ketch rig with 108 m² mainsail, 67 m² genoa, 50 m² jib and 47 m² mizzen. Equipped with Side Power SP55HYD bow thruster, Simrad navigation systems and Victron inverter/charger system. Professionally maintained and fully operational.
