Remarks :
The Westerly Konsort Duo ' <i>Quintet</i> ' (1986) is a solid and practical bilge-keel motor sailer, offering a good balance between sailing and motoring capabilities. Known for its sturdy construction and stable handling, this vessel is well-suited for coastal cruising and general
leisure sailing.
While the engine hours are unknown, the Volvo Penta 2003 diesel engine has seen regular maintenance, with key components serviced in recent years, including a water pump seal replacement in 2021. Quintet has also benefited from routine upkeep, with the last anode replacement and antifouling carried out in 2022.

The rigging and sails are in serviceable condition, with significant updates in 2019 and 2022, ensuring that the vessel is ready for general sailing purposes. Interior accommodations are comfortable, with space to sleep six, and the saloon offers good visibility and a practical layout.

While *Quintet* has seen some modern upgrades, such as a new chartplotter and recent gas system updates, it remains a classic design with the charm and quality expected from a vessel of this age. Safety equipment is up-to-date, and the overall condition of the boat suggests it has been well-cared-for, though it may benefit from ongoing attention to maintain its current standard.

In summary, *Quintet* presents a reliable option for those seeking a dependable and well-built motor sailer, suitable for a variety of sailing activities.

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
