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Construction, Mechanical and Rigging

Construction:

Grand Banks 36, built by American Marina Limited (Singapore) in 1979 to a design by Kenneth L smith Twin inboard diesel, shaft drive, twin screw. An update of a classic design, built using orthodox GRP materials and good workmanship. Heavy duty GRP mouldings, displacement hard chine hull form. Large flybridge with second helm position, seating and storage. Teak laid decks and bathing platform with ladder. Teak trim and cappings, teak and bronze bowsprit with roller. Internal and flybridge wheel steering to twin rudders. Burma teak with interior joinery. Anti-fouled (August 2017) Out of water (August 2017)

Mechanical:

2 x Ford Lehman 2715E 6 cylinder diesel engines with electric start. Flexible mounts, shaft drive to fixed 3 blade propellers. Borg Warner Satin drive. Fresh water cooled via heat exchanger, twin lever engine controls to saloon and flybridge. Full engine instrumentation. Vetus bowthruster with controls at both helm positions.

Cruise speed of 8 knots and max speed of 9 knots.

Accommodation

The accomodation offers up to 7 berths in 3 cabins, forward cabin with V berths, drawers under. Large hanging locker, new headliner 2012, door to heads compartment with Jabsco sea toilet and vanity unit with h&c water supply. Steps up to main saloon with setee berth to starboard. Stowage under and above, large drop leaf table with integral bottle rack, drawer and stowage. Quarter berth opposite to port. Drinks cabinet with drawers. Galley with stainless steel Force 10 gas hob and oven. Stainless steel sink with hot and cold water supply.

Generous storage cupboards and lockers. Large 12v fridge. Helm position and navigation area forward to starboard with full engine instrumentation and controls. Step down to aft cabin with double berth to starboard and a single berth to port with stowage under. Shelving behind bunks, large hanging locker to port, chest of drawers aft. Teak bookcase over double berth, heads compartment to starboard with Jabsco sea toilet and vanity unit with hot and cold water supply. Shower, companion to aft. all cushions and mattresses new in 2010, interior painted throughout 2010, door starboard from main saloon to wide decks. Aft cockpit with lazerette, gate to bathing platform, steps up to large flybridge with helm and seating with stowage. Full interior lighting. Blinds.

The boat was worked on through first half of 2014 systematically addressing all defects. In addition, it was repainted, varnished etc. All invoices/receipt for work carried out available.

Key items addressed:

- 1. Replacement fuel tanks and all associated pipework.
- 2. All electrics upgraded, including fitting of LED lights.
- 3. New panelling to saloon roof.
- 4. New engine instruments.
- 5. New steaming lights.
- 6. New instruments (speed, depth, AIS etc).
- 7. New GPS (inside helm).
- 8. Fitting of a holding tank (forward).
- 9. Parts of toilet (aft).
- 10. All seacocks freed; wooden bungs.
- 11. Liferaft serviced & new liferaft holder fitted.
- 12. Lifejackets serviced.
- 13. New gas cooker fitted.
- 14. New fridge fitted.
- 15. New mooring lines: permanent at berth; portable (so far unused).
- 16. Lots of work on engines and starboard injector (no problem found with latter).
- 17. Mast removed and repainted.
- 18. Various repairs to decking.
- 19. All windows refurbished including new seals

All equipment on board is fully functional.
