Construction, Mechanical and Rigging

Construction:

Moody 27 built by Marine Projects (A.H. Moody & Son) in 1982.

Bilge keel - Cast Iron

GRP hull, deck and superstructure

Transom hung rudder

Mechanical:

Beta B-20 20hp 3-cylinder diesel engine, shaft drive to a three-bladed bronze propeller.

Heat exchanger cooled with a wet exhaust water trap.

Engine new in 2012

Electrical:

12v DC system supplied by 2 x 12v Batteries4

Sterling Power battery charger - Connected to a 220v/240v AC supply when the vessel is laid up.

Water:

GRP fresh water tank.

Pumped system supplying galley sink and toilet compartment washbasin.

Sails & Rigging:

Aluminium deck stepped single spreader mast with stainless steel standing rigging. Rigging replaced 2012.

Accommodation

The two cabin accommodation is fitted out in solid teak and teak faced plywood, on white GRP mouldings. The upholstery is Blue Dralon covered, with cream PVC deckhead and hull side linings

Descending the companionway the head is to port with Jabsco manual toilet, the galley to starboard with Flavel Vanessa cooker, aft of the galley is the broad quarter berth with opening port to the cockpit.

The saloon is large for a boat of this size the port settee has the ability to become a double berth - the starboard settee becoming a single berth.

The fore-cabin has double doors and can be 2 singles or with the infill- a double berth. Storage throughout is enormous - high level, behind berths and under the berths
