

You board the boat via a large bathing platform with a transom door to port.

^{**}All equipment interfaced via Seatalk and repeated at both helm stations**

In the cockpit is a bench seat across the stern with storage lockers. The back cockpit can be extended by approximately two feet with the touch of a button. Moulded steps lead up to the flybridge, which has three-person bench seat across the helm with a second bench seat behind. There is also a large sun pad that folds over to make it even larger.

Enter the saloon via the patio doors. To starboard is L-shaped seating with storage under and a high gloss table. When the table is removed the seating converts to a double berth using the infill sofa on the port side. The saloon flooring has a Flexi-teak covering in lieu of carpets although removable carpet is also available. Beige leather upholstery in the saloon and light beige upholstery in the cabin with fitted beige carpets. Cherry Gloss interior woodwork.

Full galley located to port with a fridge, SMEV oven with grill, 2 burner gas hob, twin sinks and ample storage.

To starboard is the internal double helm seat with full engine controls. Down two steps into the companionway, the toilet/shower compartment is to port and includes the upgraded Vacu-flush system. Opposite is access to the second cabin with fully made up double berth.

Moving forward into the master cabin, there is an island double bed with storage under, a large wardrobe, lockers all round and separate access to the toilet.

'Blue Moon', a 2004 Sealine F34 with twin Volvo Penta D4-210hp diesel engines and EVC controls. Inventory includes Eberspatcher heating, TV & DVD player, Bowthruster, Full Raymarine Navigation suite, Battery charger, Stereo/Radio system, Search light, Flexi teak galley flooring, Teak flooring at transom, Teak swim platform, Vacuflush toilet with macerator, Full camper canvas and flybridge covers, plus much more.
