## Jeanneau Sunlight 31



The Jeanneau Sunlight 31 retains its popularity as a good-sized cruiser ideal for a small family or couple to get out onto the water. The spacious cockpit with guard wire surrounds makes the deck space functional and safe. With a clean interior, she will accommodate a maximum of seven people but will be comfortable with four or five. ### **Accommodation**

#### Overview:

This is a fine example of the Jeanneau Sunlight 31. She has been well looked after and the current owner has prepared her for coastal cruising and holidays. She has a clean interior with room for a maximum of seven people, but this would be more comfortable with four or five.

Below deck is spacious and airy. With a forward double berth to the bow and a double aft cabin at the stern, this boat can comfortably accommodate a small family, couple, and guests with the saloon further converting to a double berth.
