Beta Marine 4 cylinder 43hp diesel engine
Shaft driven with PSS dry shaft seal
3 blade Brunton varifold propeller
Ambassador Marine stripper rope cutter
Single lever morse engine control positioned on the helm pedestal

3 x 12v 105amp batteries
Batteries are housed in their own sealed GRP battery box

Charging from the engine alternator
Spectralite solar panel for charging

Digital voltmeter at the switchboard

Saloon with raised U-shaped seating to starboard (will convert to a double berth)
Raised bench seating opposite to port
Chart table to port with forward-facing navigators seat & all instruments
Finished in maple which gives a very light effect with blue upholstery
Excellent storage throughout
Eberspacher diesel fired hot air heating

Forward Cabin:

Double V berth with infill
Hanging locker

Offset to starboard aft of the forward cabin

Positioned aft of the bunk berths to port

U-shaped saloon seating which is raised to starboard
Excellent panoramic views from the saloon seating from the deck saloon windows
Bench seating to port
