The Camper and Nicholson 30 is a great ocean going yacht that handles all conditions in her stride. This Nicholson 30 has been cruised through all of the British Isles and further afield towards the med, she is very well equipped for extended cruising at sea, she comes with so many extras it is hard to list. The Nicholson 30 has been excellently maintained each season without fail; she had a recent insurance survey in 2010 that is available. Accommodation

Sleeps 4 in 2 cabins

Forward cabin has a double V berth with infil

Two burner gas hob, grill and oven Stainless steel sink Cold pressurised water

Built in 1974 by Camper and Nicholson to the 1/4 ton rule
GRP Hull, deck and superstructure
Fin keel
Transom hung rudder with skeg

Tiller steering

Powered by a Volvo Penta 2020B three cylinder, 19hp diesel engine (serviced each season)
Single lever morse control
Shaft driven to a two blade folding propeller (2011, new anode 2013)
Cruise speed 6 knots max speed 7 knots
