## **Construction:**

Built in 2000 by Dufour Yachts La Rochelle  
Designed by Yann Chabaud  
GRP hull deck and superstructure  
Teak laid cockpit seating and cockpit floor  
Wheel steering  
Fin keel

## **Mechanics:**

Volvo Penta 2040, 40hp diesel engine  
Fresh water heat exchanger cooling  
Saildrive (seal replaced in 2010)  
Three blade folding propeller  
Rope cutter  
Single lever morse control  
Vetus bow thruster  
Eberspacher diesel heating

## **Accommodation:**

Sleeps five in two cabins  
Forward cabin with a large double V berth  
Aft Cabin with a large double berth  
Interior joinery in teak

### **Forward Cabin:**

Large double V berth  
Under berth stowage  
Open shelves to port and starboard  
Hanging locker to starboard  
Cabin bench seat to starboard  
Hanging locker to port  
Large deck hatch  
Small deck hatch

### **Saloon:**

Longitudinal galley to port  
Single berth to starboard  
C-shaped seating to starboard  
Bench seat facing to starboard in the saloon  
Cupboards to starboard  
Behind and under seating stowage (ample)  
Large deck hatch  
Small deck hatch  
Port and starboard portlights

### **Galley:**

Longitudinal galley to port  
Eno two burner gas hob and oven  
Large top loading refrigerator and freezer box  
Double stainless steel sink  
Hot and cold pressurized water  
Manual sea water tap  
Shelves and cupboard stowage  
Under work surface drawers and cupboards

### **Chart Table:**

Forward facing chart table, just aft of the saloon seating, to starboard  
Chart light  
Stowage under chart table, under seat  
Hanging locker behind the chart table seat

### **Heads:**

Large separate head  
Manual Jabsco sea water toilet  
Single hand basin  
Hot and cold pressurized water, from chrome mixer tap  
Shower with separate chrome shower and mixer tap  
Teak shower seat  
Shower sump

Shelves and cupboards

**Aft Cabin:**

Large double aft cabin to port  
Lots of headroom (doesn't feel claustrophobic!)  
Open shelf  
Hanging locker

**Aft Store:**

Aft store room to starboard  
Perfect for wet weather gear, tools etc.  
Large hanging locker
