Built in 2009 by Dufour Yachts La Rochelle

Designed by Umberto Felci

Hand laminated GRP hull with Twaron reinforcements at keel area

NPG gelcoat, the first layer of cloth impregnated with NPG resin, forming an optimum

barrier against osmosis

Inner moulded hull bottom, structural grid laminated to the hull.

Deck in PVC foam core sandwich, moulded by injection process (Resin Transfer Moulding)

giving significant weight saving and an excellent interior finish

Cast iron fin keel, bolt loads taken up by stainless steel backing plate.

Semi-elliptical rudder, filled with closed cell epoxy foam. Stainless steel solid stock

Rudder stock head under helmsman's sole for installing the emergency tiller
