NPG Gelcoat with first layer of cloth impregnated with NPG resin forming an optimum barrier against osmosis
Inner moulded hull bottom, structural framing laminated to the hull
PVC foam core sandwich, moulded by injection process (Resin Transfer Moulding) for significant weight saving and excellent interior finish
Long draft 1.90m, lead keel!!!
Bolt loads taken up by stainless steel backing plate

The Dufour 34 Performance was designed to give performance sailing enthusiasts a feel for speed, control and maintain a strong level of comfort.

The 34 Performance sails extremely well, she handles like a big dinghy although feels safe & secure when in a seaway.

This yacht is easily handled by two crew, or even single handed, giving excellent passage time with her turn of speed, this is helped by her two blade folding propeller new in 2014, deep LEAD fin keel, performance mast & a great sail plan.

There are elements to this yacht that any sailing enthusiast has seen throughout their sailing experience, weather that be sailing big boats, sportsboats, or dinghies.

All deck gear & running blocks are by Harken, which many see as the leading brand for sailing hardware, every aspect to make this boat sail as comfortably & easily as possible has been thought of.

The mainsheet traveller, genoa tracks, cars & backstay all have good purchase systems to make sail handling as simple yet effective as possible.

The Dufour 34 Performance does not neglect the cruising lifestyle that people of all ages want from a boat, below decks she has many components that make life at sea that bit more luxurious. She benefits from EBERSPACHER diesel fired cabin heating in all cabins, she also has a adequate galley with a two burner hob & oven, she has a large refrigerator for food stores, hot and cold pressurised water & plenty of stowage.

Both the owner's cabin, and crew cabin are a generous size, with full length double berths and two more single berths in the saloon for when sailing with a full crew, she also has a good size heads with a shower and an efficient wet locker.

The condition of this Dufour 34 Performance is excellent throughout, if you are searching for a yacht that gives great performance without being a handful to sail then you should certainly be looking at this yacht!!
