Broker Remarks

This Moody 376 is a well-equipped example, she benefits from being re-engined, she has a bow thruster, new standing rigging, new sprayhood, electric anchor windlass and she has been reupholstered apart from the aft cabin. The hull was sanded back to gelcoat (not blasted) in 2016 and epoxy coated, the teak cockpit floor and seating was also replaced in 2017 along with all of the windows and deck hatches. The Moody 376 has superb accommodation especially with the private aft cabin and the perfect yacht for extended cruising.





