Encapsulated lead ballast castings around a galvanized lifting centerplate (blocks, topping lift & centreboard line new 2020)
Transom hung rudder with stainless steel pintle & gudgeon

All mast bands & fittings in stainless steel with associated fastenings

Deck stepped mast on a substantial stainless steel tabernacle

Stainless steel gaff collar with rubber protection on bearing surface

We are the second owners and bought her in 2018. We have sailed her in the West Country, principally from Salcombe to the Isles of Scilly.

A fantastic family boat, she has been sailed 4 up, 2 up and extensively singlehanded.

With her lifting keel, Tribute has been ideal for beach exploration and creek-crawling, but she has also proved herself in challenging conditions offshore and is well worth her RCD B classification.
