

Mechanical and Rigging

Construction:

Built by Northshore in 1981 Designed by Wyatt & Freeman GRP hull deck & wheelhouse Painted hull topsides Long keel Keel mounted rudder Enclosed wheelhouse steering position using a wheel

Mechanics:

Beta Marine 38hp diesel engine (NEW 2014) ENGINE HOURS 160!!! Hydraulic gearbox All new stern gear was replaced when the engine was installed Three-blade fixed-pitch bronze propellor Rope cutter Single lever morse engine control

Electrics:

4 x 12v, 80ah batteries Charging from solar panel & engine alternator

Tankage:

Fuel capacity 200 litres in a single stainless steel tank (tank emptied & cleaned in 2021) Freshwater capacity of approximately 100 litres in a single stainless steel tank

Rigging:

Ketch rig Aluminium anodised main & mizzen mast Single spreader masts Deck stepped masts Lewmar 8 single speed main mast winch Stainless steel standing rigging Terylene running rigging Reefing main and mizzen sails Genoa furling

Sails:

Main & mizzen sails are tan in colour with a white genoa All sails are in excellent condition with vibrant tan colour, crisp & stiff heavy cloth Genoa Mainsail (NEW 2010 HARDILY USED) Mizzen sail (NEW 2010 HARDILY USED) Spare white main & mizzen sails

Remarks :

The Fisher 30 is a very popular model, she has good internal volume for a 30 footer and her sea keeping ability is excellent, she sails well as a motor sailor and she has a replacement 38hp Beta engine which was new in 2014 along with the hydraulic gearbox, so she has plenty of power and reliability under motor. The engine has only had 160 engine hours put on her since new in 2014 and has been professionally maintained!

She has been in the same ownership for a number of years now and has mainly been cruised around the southwest coast, under the current ownership she has been wintered ashore every year and also berths on a tidal mooring so drys out.
