Mechanical and Rigging

Construction:

Built in 1986 by Island Packet Yachts, in Tampa Florida, USA

Designed by Bob Johnson

GRP hull with solid glass laminate, pressure-fed impregnation which is hand-laid with vinylester resin (The laminate thickens progressively from the sheer line to the foot of the keel) Decks are built using a resin-based, medium-density polyester core instead of foam or balsa lvory Vinylester gelcoat finish to the hull & deck

Encapsulated long keel with lead ballast (minimizes fouling or impact damage to the keel, rudder & propellor)

Semi-balanced, keel-hung rudder

Forward Owners Cabin:

The forward owner's cabin is superb, with the entire beam of the yacht utilized for a truly luxurious cabin

There is a generously sized double berth

Drawers, cabinets, storage bins & a deep hanging locker provide ample space for personal gear

Two overhead hatches & several opening ports will keep this area bright & well ventilated

Main Saloon:

The spacious, central saloon area is equally suited for social gatherings, off-watch rest bite, or dining

The hinged table is secured against a bulkhead-mounted bottle & glass rack, this easily lowers to make a large saloon table for up to 7 guests

An exceptional amount of interior stowage is available in the saloon, largely due to the generous tankage being centrally located below the cabin sole. This feature also keeps these considerable weights low & close to the centre of the yacht to maximize stability & minimize trim changes.

The starboard settee seating pulls out to provide a large double berth

Beautiful hand-crafted cabinetry & joinery throughout the yacht with varnished solid teak & holly cabin sole board

Well-placed & substantial handrails

Numerous opening portlights

Durable, easily maintained overhead coachroof surfaces make this saloon & the entire interior attractive, comfortable & practical

Chart Table:

Linear full-size chart table to starboard and aft of the saloon seating Switchboard & navigation equipment to hand

Galley:

The galley, immediately to the starboard side of the companionway, is easily accessible to the cockpit & the main saloon

A generous countertop with moulded fiddles provides ample workspace for food preparation Numerous drawers, lockers & laminate-lined cabinets offer an abundance of space for provisioning & kitchenware storage

Seaward Princess three-burner gas hob & oven

Double stainless steel sinks

Hot water is provided by either calorifier when under engine

Cold pressurised water system & a separate manual tap for freshwater

A well-insulated icebox features a double gasket lid that to reveal a divided Adler Barbour refrigerator

The non-slip moulded galley sole provides secure footing & easy maintenance, it extends throughout the companionway, chart table & aft head areas Overhead lighting

Aft Heads:

Entry from either the main saloon or through a private door in the aft cabin

Moulded hand basin with hot & cold pressurised water

Electric sea water toilet (NEW 2022)

Bulkhead mounted shower unit with a curtain

Shower drain with an electric drain pump discharging overboard configured to work at rest or under sail

Folding teak shower seat

Aft Cabin:

The aft cabin has privacy doors to the companionway area in the main saloon & also to the aft heads

Pullman-style athwartship bunk

Large hanging locker & a generous bureau with several compartments.

Two opening portlights, an overhead deck hatch which gives natural light & provides excellent ventilation

Teak & holly cabin sole board

Remarks:

This Island Packet 38 is a stunning example; she is well-specified, and her condition is excellent!

She is set up for long-distance cruising and is a perfect blue-water cruising vessel. She benefits from having a large tankage for both water and fuel; she has solar panel charging, windvane self-steering, an adequate battery, a reliable, powerful Yanmar engine and the standing rigging was replaced in 2019!

She is equipped with a recent electronics package with a Garmin radar, chartplotter and AIS system.

Island packets are built to a high standard and are known as a go-anywhere safe and comfortable sea-going vessel; the boat is currently on hard standing and ready to view.

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
