# **ACCOMMODATION**

## Sleeps 4/6 in 3 double berths in 2 cabins

- Large light and airy cabin
- Curtains
- Hanging lockers
- Diesel Heating

The galley is just the right size, complete with a microwave, a large sink and a sensible-size fridge. The seating opposite is a three-adult or two-adult/two-child affair. The forward bench seat converts – by reversing the backrest and sliding the base aft – into a double forward-facing navigator's seat.

The bottom of the companionway steps leads to a mid-cabin on the port side and a heads to starboard. The forward cabin has plenty of natural light from two portholes and a deck hatch, lots of space around the berth and a full-length hanging locker.

# Remarks:

**Quicksilver 855 Activ Weekend for sale.** This is the largest of Quicksilver's cabin cruisers and ideal for a family. Visibility from the wheelhouse is great and seated or standing the helm position is spot on. A fold-down footboard complements the high helm seat, as does a side door leading out to a side deck enclosed by a tall bulwark and chunky guard rails. The twin-prop Bravo 3 sterndrive gives you a fantastic grip on the water.

The cockpit provides seating for six or more around its table with the capacity to extend in size by sliding back the transom bench seat, which is mounted on discreet rails, increasing the size of the cockpit by about 20%.

A well-made boat, whose finish, particularly the joinery, does not smack of compromise with a good blend of living accommodation and practicality.

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
