Construction and rigging:

Designed by Johann Anker and built by Borresen of Denmark in 1967.

HIN # DN240 and initially known as CRAZY VI before being shipped to Hong Kong in the 1970's and renamed WANDERER with sail # HKG6

Carvel planked in mahogany on steamed Oak frames, and with copper fastenings.

Integral long keel

She raced successfully in and around Hong Kong, and benefitted from her Borresen pedigree, known for building quick and stiff boats. She was re-imported to the UK in 2007 and has since been epoxy sheathed with clear epoxy to minimize maintenance and weight and to maximize stiffness and performance, whilst retaining the stunning varnished appearance.

She has a very successful racing history and has taken part in Cowes Classic Week in the last few years in her current ownership, and with excellent results.

Original spruce mast and decent sail wardrobe will enable WANDERER to continue to be a race winner in the right hands, or a truly lovely cruising yacht if preferred. Lightly used twin axle top notch bespoke road trailer included.

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
