

Construction, Mechanical and Rigging

Built by Hanse Yachts AG, Germany to a design by Jodel and Vrolijk

- White GRP hull, deck and superstructure
- Antifoul, anodes, hull polish June 2021
- Teak laid slats to cockpit seats and cockpit sole (stripped back and treated October 2021)
- Self-draining cockpit to seat 6
- Ocean 'A' RCD categorisation
- Full-length cockpit cover providing extended accommodation and weather protection

Hull and Construction:

- White GRP hull
- dark grey double waterlines
- Isophtalic gelcoat
- Vinylester 1st layer
- Bulk laminate Polyester (orthophtalic or DCPD)
- Balsa Sandwich construction/solid below waterline
- Bulkheads laminated to hull and deck
- GRP strongbacks
- Moulded non-slip deck surface on coach roof
- Hull windows
- Fin keel
- Spade rudder with single large, folding leather-covered Lewmar wheel

Engine:

- Yanmar 3YM30 29hp inboard diesel engine
- Engine serviced June 2021
- Single lever morse control and panel at helm
- Revolution counter
- Engine hour meter
- Saildrive
- Seawater-cooled with strainer
- 2-bladed propeller (new anode)
- Bow thruster
- Engine room sound insulated

Electrical:

- 12v system
- 1 x engine battery
- 1 x domestic battery
- 2 x isolator switches
- 240 volt socket with USB
- Alternator charging
- Fused switch panel

SmartPlug 16A/230V Shore power inlet

Water System:

- Hot and cold pressurised water
- Heated by engine and calorifier

Tankage:

- Fuel capacity 137 litres in 1 x plastic tank (under starboard side of aft cabin berth)
- Fresh water capacity 320 litres in 1 x plastic tank (under fore cabin berth)
- Fuel and water filler caps on deck
- Holding tank

Rigging:

- 9/10 Fractional Bermudan sloop
- Mast stepped by cast aluminium deck post supported by internal metal kingpost down to keel
- Selden silver anodised aluminium mast and boom
- 2 sets of mast spreaders
- Selden rod kicker
- 5mm and 600 1 x 19 stainless steel standing rigging
- Forestay
- Split backstay
- Selden Furlex 200s headsail roller furling system
- Self-tacking jib track
- Running rigging (jib sheet, jib furling line, topping lift, mainsheet, kicking strap, 2 x halvards)
- Main sheet well forward from cockpit
- Mast lines all led aft under-deck to cockpit for ease of crew movement & control
- 2 x Clutch arrays on coachroof beneath sprayhood

Winches:

- 2 x Lewmar 40 AST combined self-tailing winches for halyard and jib sheet
- 2 x Lewmar self-tailing halyard winches (on coachroof)

Sails:

- Fully battened main (2010)
 - Slab reefing with 2 reefing points
 - Hanse single line reefing system (cockpit handling)
 - Mainsail 'stackpack' lazy-bag system
 - Lazy-jacks
 - Self-tacking roller furling jib with UV sacrificial strip (2010)

- Good sized double V-berth
- Made-to measure mattress protector topper
- Mattress with mesh air mat under
- Sheet
- Hanging locker & shelving
- Large opening skylight hatch
- 2 x further deck-opening portlights
- Overhead shelves
- Under-berth Stowage
- Double 240V socket with USB

Twin Aft Cabins:

- Separated from saloon by a door
- 6' 1" headroom
- Double berths
- Mattresses with mesh air mats under
- 1 x fitted mattress protector topper & sheet
- Clothes locker & shelving

Heads (to port):

- Separated from saloon by a door
- Vanity unit with basin
- Ample locker shelving and cupboard storage
- Large opening portlight and Oceanair blind
- Jabsco marine toilet
- Shower with folding screen and shower seat
- Seasmart sanitiser
- Electric drain pump
- Holding tank with sea discharge and pump-out via deck fitting

Hanse 375 performance cruiser for sale. HENDRICKS is a well-set up modern looking boat from this renowned German builder. Deliberately designed to offer simple handling for short-handed crews with her self-tacking jib and spacious, uncluttered decks, she also provides great accommodation below with 3 good sized cabins, a practical galley and a swish heads compartment. As Duncan Kent says in his 2010 Sail magazine review: "This is a reasonably priced, good-looking and easily handled family cruiser. Her sailing performance is impressive, and she has comfortable and airy accommodations for four or six"
