Construction

- GRP white hull, deck, superstructure and cabin in ash

- Tiller steering to spade rudder (tiller extension)

 - Deck gear, including new winches and jammers (2009) (Majority Harken)
 - Transom strengthening for racing (2010)
 - Interior wood lacquer (2011)
 - Chainplate strengthening (2012)
 - New repair of old starboard side damage, (Prior owner) (2013)
 - New epoxy gelcoat of keel and hull below waterline (2016)

Engine

- Volvo 2002 18hp diesel engine last serviced in February 2023
- Direct drive to folding propeller
- Cruising speed c. 5-5.5 knts
- Fuel capacity = 12 gallons (estimated)
- Extra work carried out during current ownership:
 - Annual routine maintenance oil, filters, fan belt etc
 - Cutlass bearing last replaced 2022
 - Sacrificial anodes replaced annually
 - Head cleaned and reassembled (2022)
