Accommodation

Accommodation consists of large saloon to center and offset to starboard with a a nav and instrument panel facing aft bulkhead. The galley is on the same level to port and is U shaped with good worktop space.

The accommodation in the two hulls is almost identical with each hull have a queen sized double forward (atwartships) there a further single forward with access from the main section or through a deck hatch.

These forward sections are often used for storage.

There is a heads and shower then each hull has a double cabin aft.

Remarks :

This **2005 Maxim 380 catamaran** has excellent sea handling capabilities. She has proved ideal for Greek Island hopping .Up to 8 guests can enjoy the comfortable saloon and cockpit dining areas. The galley design incorporates a spacious saloon and forward facing galley. The accommodation consists of 4 double cabins (plus crew berths) and 2 quarter berth crew cabins, a large spacious aft and fore deck. She is a modern looking catamaran and similar in style to Fontaine Pajot Athena, Lagoon 38 or a Leopard 38.
