- Reinforced points (keel, rudder, chain plates, hull-deck joint) help to strengthen the structure.
- A structural monolithic inner moulding is bonded and laminated to the hull. Its structural role is important as it takes and absorbs the stresses at pressure points (shrouds, chain plate tie rods, keel, rudder, etc.) and spreads any loads guaranteeing reduced strain on the hull.
- The surface material of the inner moulding makes cleaning easier and provides a better finish.

RCD Status: It is our understanding that the yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/2SEC (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised A — "Ocean".

Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- The deck is sandwich construction (glass fibre and balsa) for an optimal strength/weight ratio and excellent thermal and sound insulation.
- A 'diamond point' non-slip surface is applied to all areas of work and movement on deck.
- Teak laid decking on side decks with further teak on cockpit sole, cockpit seating and bathing platform

- The hull/deck joint is screwed and bonded and surrounded by a teak bulwark screwed in position. This mechanical joint ensures a watertight assembly and improves safety when moving around on deck.
- Teak capped bulwark

Keel & Rudder:

- Standard draft keel.
- The keel is fitted to the boat with a system of screws and stainless-steel backing plates and bonded.
- The keel is cast iron construction.
- To improve their durability the keels are given an anti-corrosion treatment and improved finish in the factor before assembly, using epoxy based coatings and paint.
- Balanced rudder with glass fibre composite stock.

- Engine compartment soundproofed with insulating foam. Ventilation is ensured by an air intake and forced air outlet on the transom.
- Access by companionway steps, through an opening supported by gas struts.
- 2 side access hatches in aft cabins for maintenance.
- Water and diesel filters and sediment reservoirs.
- The engine panel with integral key start is situated in the cockpit by the starboard helm position.

Propulsion & Steering:

- Maxprop 3-bladed folding propellor
- Stainless steel propeller shaft with GRP protection moulded into the hull.
- Maxpower Series 100 12vDC bow thruster with control at starboard helm.
- Two 915 mm diameter column-mounted steering wheels. With cable transmission system
- Emergency tiller access point and emergency tiller.

Voltage Systems:

- 12vDC domestic system and 230vAC ring main from shore power.

Battery Banks:

- 1x 110Ah 12vDC engine battery situated under the sole by the companionway.
- 4 x 140Ah 12vDC service batteries joined in parallel to supply 560Ah @12v
- 2x 12vDC Exida Maxima 900DC AGM deep cycle bow thruster batteries located forward

Battery Charger:

- Dolphin 12vDC/230vAC 40Amp automatic battery charger.

Alternators:

- Yanmar 80A engine mounted alternator.

Shore Power:

- 230vAC shore power system with ring-main and 230vAC sockets throughout yacht.

Other Electrical:

- Backlit electrical panel: 10 x 12V switches + 11 fused switches + 4 x 220 V switches.
- Bi-polar circuit breaker.
- 12 V cigarette lighter socket.
- Double protection for electrical panel, differential and bipolar thermal magneto for 220V system and 12V thermal breaker.

Plumbing Systems:

Fresh Water & Water Heating System:

- 12vDC pressurised water system
- Hot water supplied via engine driven calorifier or 230vAC immersion heater element powered in 40 litre h water tank

Water Supplies:

- Pressurized hot & cold water supplied to galley and heads.

Bilge Pumps:

- 12vDC central electric bilge pump with automatic switch.
- Manual bilge pump in cockpit.

Grey & Black Water:

- Grey and black water discharges overboard or to holding tank (blackwater).

Fresh Water:

2x molded water tanks fixed to the inner hull moulding (235 L under port aft cabin berth + 330 L under fore cabin berth) giving a total of 565 litres (124.3 gallons).

- Two aluminium deck fillers for water. Tanks filled separately.
- 1/4 turn valves for tank selection.
- Fitted with electric gauge

Fuel:

- moulded 235 litres fuel tank (51.7 gallons)
- Fitted with electronic gauge
- Tank located under the starboard aft berth.

Blackwater :

- 80 liters (17.6 gallons) rigid black water holding tank servicing aft heads.
- Holding tank discharges to sea.

- Woodwork in the saloon, cabins, galley and chart table area is in fruit-tree-stained wood.
- Soles are laminated with 'parquet look' finish.

Owners Cabin Forward

Headroom: 1.92m. Double berth: 2m x 1.60m island berth with high-density foam mattress and slatted base for great comfort. Large drawer under berth. Locker to port with oddments locker under hanging section. 2 lockers to either side of berth. Hanging locker to starboard with interior mirror. Dressing table with mirror, oddments

locker. High shelves each side of berth. Large opening hatch (442 x 442) with blind / mosquito screen. Opening hatch (260 x 260) with blind / mosquito screen. Two fixed hull ports (one each side of hull) with curtains. Three halogen deckhead lights with switch by entrance door. 3 reading lights. 220v socket beside dressing table.

Forward heads:

Accessed through fore cabin. One-piece moulded head compartment for good watertightness and maintenance. Separate shower with curved pivoting PMMA shower panel. Electric marine WC. Synthetic resin worktop and washbasin. Hot and cold mixer tap. Mirror. Locker with closed shelf above. Locker under washbasin with wastebin and paper holder. Opening deck hatch (260 x 260) with blind / mosquito screen. Three halogen deckhead lights with switch. Towel holder on door.
