Additional Information

Main Sail and Genoa are old, Code zero is new

The autoPilot rudder sensor replaced in June 2020 needs re-calibration this service is already scheduled and paid for

Bow thruster replaced in June 2020

On-Board power inverter fully functional and can be used but the trigger relay has a loose connection, needs to be tightened

The swim platform fully functional, but small seat pistons need replacement

Last survey: February 2018 / Last antifoul: May 2019 / Last out of water: May 2019
