Mechanical and Rigging

Sails and Spars:

Masthead Bermudan rigged sloop. Starlight silver anodised aluminium mast and boom. Spinnaker pole. Stainless steel standing rigging (new 2010). Terylene running rigging. Slab reefing mainsail. Rotostay headsail furling system. Manually adjustable backstay.

Mechanical Systems:

Located under companionway 2001 Lombardini LDW502M 2-cylinder 13hp diesel engine (approx.642 hours). Freshwater cooled via heat exchanger, last service June 2022 by the owner. Single level control with electric start. Shaft drive to fixed 3-bladed propeller. Last out of water maintenance February 2022. Stainless steel 25 litre fuel tank. Cruising speed of 5 knots and maximum 6 knots.

Electrical Systems:

3 x 12-volt batteries (2 x domestic 60/80Ah, 1 x engine 100Ah,) charged via engine alternator and 12-volt battery charger. 240v Shorepower system with ring main. There is a solar panel and wind generator fitted.

History and Construction:

Trapper 500 built by Trapper Yachts in 1973. Blue painted GRP hull with grey superstructure and decks with blue painted non-slip surfaces. Cast iron fin keel. Tiller steering to spade rudder. Self-draining cockpit. This yacht was last out of the water in February 2022 when the hull was polished and antifouled. Some remedial osmosis treatment was professionally treated. This yacht has been owned by the current owner for the past three years and is looking to buy a larger yacht.

Accommodation

This Trapper 500 offers 5 berths in 2 cabins with approx. 5'10" max. headroom.

The Forepeak has a V berth and stowage areas. There is a Heads compartment to port with a marine toilet with a 150 Litre holding tank, wash basin, storage cupboard and further stowage opposite.

The Saloon has a dinette table to port which can convert to form a double berth, a settee to starboard and ample lockers.

Aft and to port is a sliding chart table. The Galley is aft and to starboard consisting of a two-burner gas stove with grill and oven, galley sink, fridge, manually pumped cold water supply and stowage. Upholstery finished in fawn brocade. It has a 60 Litre water tank
