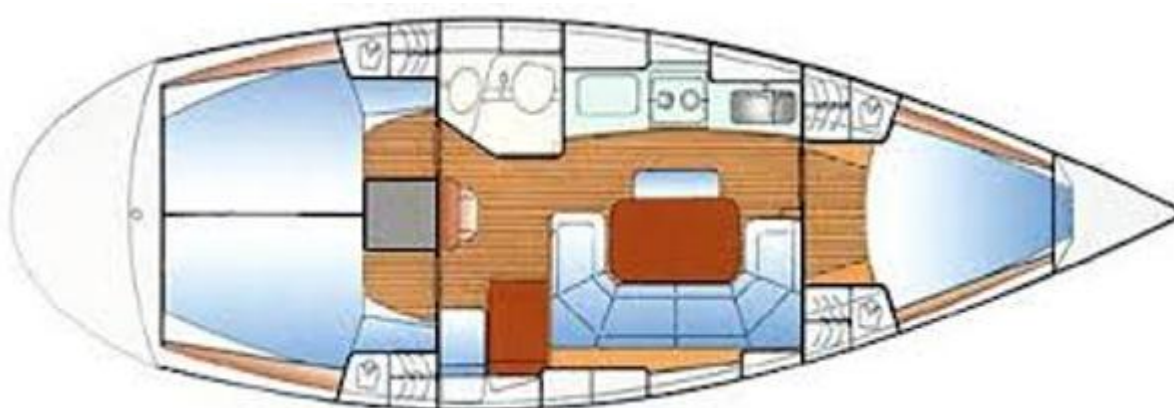

## Mechanical and Rigging

### Construction:

Built by Bavaria Yachts GmbH in 1998  
Designed by J & J Design  
GRP hull deck & superstructure  
Coppercoat antifoul system (APPLIED 2020)  
Cast iron bulb keel  
Spade rudder  
Rudder bearings replaced 2017  
Wheel steering with a leather-covered wheel  
Heads seacock replaced 2017

### Mechanics:

Volvo Penta MD2030-C 29hp diesel engine (SERVICED & WINTERISED ANNUALLY & currently winterised)  
Saildrive transmission (DIAPHRAM REPLACED IN 2017)  
Freshwater cooled via a heat exchanger  
Single lever morse control at the binnacle  
Two blade fixed pitch propellor

Eberspacher diesel fired cabin heating system

### Electrics:

Two x 12V, 130AH leisure batteries (NEW 2017)  
Single 12V, 46ah engine start battery  
Weaco mains powered battery charger  
Charging from the engine alternator  
80W solar panel & charge regulator (NEW 2020)  
240V shorepower system with switchboard & circuit breakers  
LED internal lighting

Freshwater capacity 350 litres in two polyethene tanks

## Accommodation

Sleeps 8 in three double cabins and the saloon

Forward cabin with a large double v berth

Saloon with U-shaped seating to starboard Bespoke saloon table has multi-function as dining table, coffee table, and double berth support

Linear galley to port

Full-size forward-facing chart table to starboard

Separate heads positioned aft of the galley to port

Two port & starboard double aft cabins

Internal joinery in mahogany

Teak & holly cabin sole boards

Dark Blue fabric upholstery in cabins

Hard-wearing blue vinyl upholstery in saloon

Eberspacher diesel fired cabin heating

Interior LED lighting throughout

Hot water from calorifier & immersion heater

Full canvas cockpit enclosure creates a covered on deck area

### Forward Cabin:

Large double v berth

Hanging locker

Storage & water tank under the double berth

Hanging locker & shelved locker

Large opening deck hatch & vent

Dressing seat to starboard

Ample space for changing between the berth and the bulkhead

### Saloon:

The saloon features a large U shaped seating area to starboard

Fixed saloon table with inlaid Bavaria logo & double end drop leafs

There is ample storage both beneath & behind the settee seating, this also has the facility to convert to a double berth

Eye-level fixed portlights & a large Lewmar opening deck hatch

### Galley:



Linear galley to port  
Smev 2 burner cooker with oven  
Double stainless steel sinks with hot & cold pressurised water and seawater tap  
Large coolbox with isotherm fridge & thermostatic control  
Storage above & below the worktop  
Eyelevel & overhead portlights

Heads:

Positioned aft of the galley to port  
Manual Jabsco seawater toilet  
Moulded hand basin & worktop  
Hot & cold water shower  
Storage above & below  
Opening portlight

Chart Table:

Chart table to starboard  
Storage within & locker beneath  
Chart light  
Moulded panel for electronics & electric panel  
Bookshelf, seat with further storage

Aft Cabins:

2 x identical double aft cabins  
Large hanging locker  
Opening portlights  
Opening cockpit portlights (allows extra light into the cabins)  
Water tank to port  
Fuel tank to starboard

Cockpit:

Full canvas cockpit enclosure (extends the internal living space for alfresco entertaining of guests when at anchor etc)  
A nice deep cockpit with sufficient space to safely accommodate a full crew when on a passage in comfort  
Teak laid cockpit seats  
2 x ample cockpit lockers  
Walkthrough transom to the bathing platform with a full-width removable bench seat provided for the helmsman  
Cockpit shower
