Designed by J & J Design, Built by Dufour France in 2001

The hull is laid up in glass fibre laminate and polyester resin and was Epoxied from new. Unlike some more recent and economical yacht construction techniques, the structural inner mouldings are solidly laminated to the hull making a stiff and homogeneous assembly.
