The Dreadnought 32 is a fibreglass replica of the Tahiti Ketch that was designed by John Hanna in 1932. William Crealock made a few design modifications for Dreadnought Boatworks in Carpinteria, California who produced 83 hulls between 1973 and 1982.

The **Heads** is located between the saloon and forward cabin to port and comes with a marine W.C. and hand basin.

Galley opposite the heads to starboard, comes complete with a "Plastimo Neptune 2500" 2 x burner gas cooker with oven and grill, sink and storage lockers.

Forward facing **Chart table** aft of the heads to port

Settee berth aft of the chart table to port with a saloon table and a settee berth opposite to starboard. Loads of storage lockers.

Good access to the engine bay by removing the companionway steps.
